


Quick Guide for NCCER/Pearson Test Generator Access

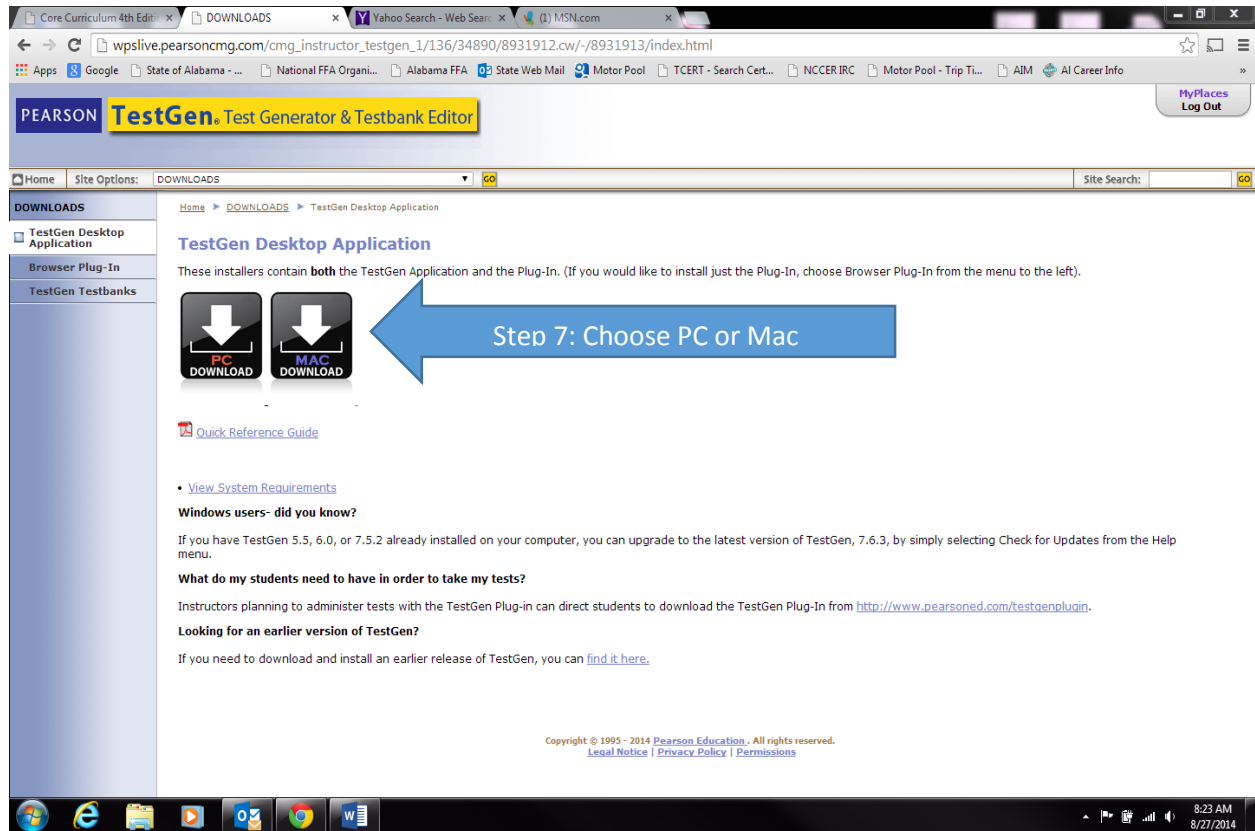
The **TestGen Desktop Application** is [publisher-supplied testbanks](#).

Step 7. Depending upon your system Click the PC or MAC tab to download (if your school or school system has security features or firewalls that prevent you from downloading content you will need to contact your Technology Administrator)



Step 8. Follow the steps to download the content as they appear on screen. Save the TestGen file where you can find it. The default is to save it to the C:/ drive.

Step 9. Go back to the NCCER IRC using the same link as in Step 1

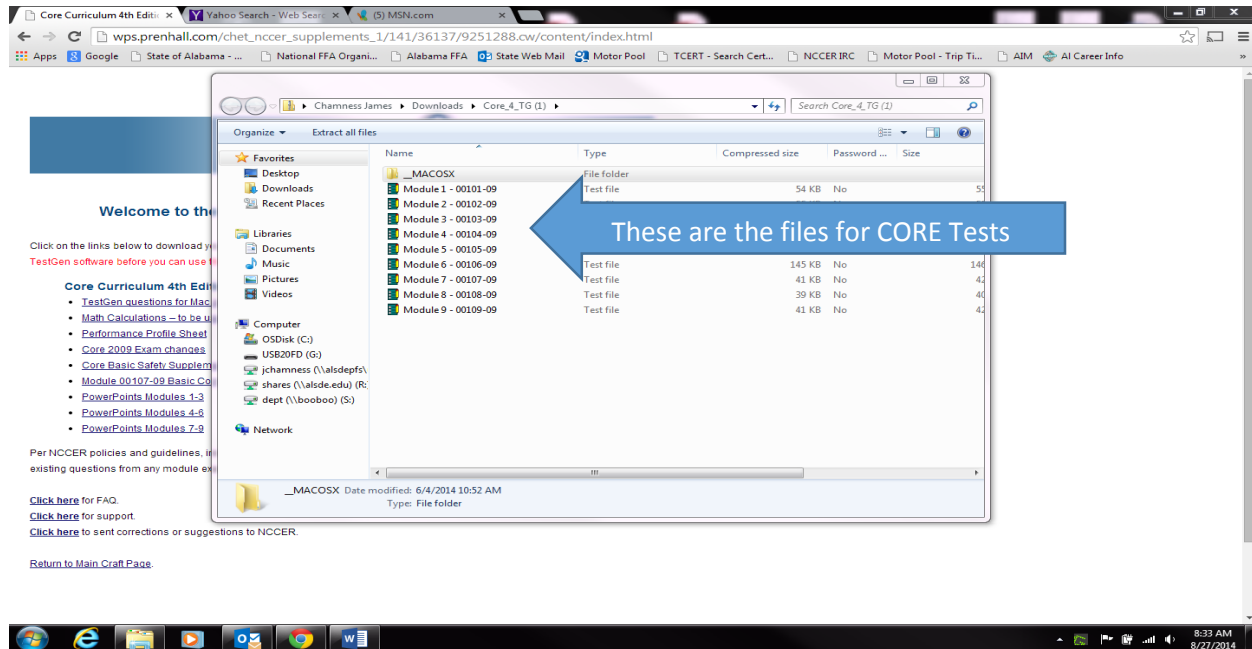

Step 12. When download the files, you should see a folder that looks like this. Remember where you saved these files or copy them to a file you are familiar with. **Keep these files secure.**



Step 13. Click on one of the files (On your computer you may have to unzip the file. To do this right click and click on unzip). The file should open in the TestGen.

*****Repeat Steps 12 and 13 to generate you NCCER CORE Tests. These test can no longer be modified and should be presented as is.**
