

## Classroom Project Display

### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this contest is to allow students and instructors an opportunity to showcase all the great work being done inside the classroom each year. It also enables more students to be a part of the state conference. The event's purpose is to showcase our students' classroom projects and handiwork. Encourage your students to enter the display so we can show the public the craftsmanship that exists in the state's career technical classrooms.

**It is the intent to Display the Process of the Project and NOT necessarily to bring the actual project to display. (display photos showing the process)**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

The contest is open to both high school and college/postsecondary active SkillsUSA members. Entries may consist of 1, 2 or 3 students. A group leader must be identified. There is limit of 3 projects submitted from any school.

### **SCOPE OF THE CONTEST**

1. **All project entries must include a 3 Ring Notebook (SkillsUSA Official 3 ring binder) with the following enclosed information:**
  - a. **Name of school**
  - b. **Name of instructor**
  - c. **Name of students and group leader of the project *(Only the group leaders name will be called out during the awards ceremony. All team members will receive a medal on stage and should be present for pictures)***
  - d. **Learning Objective of the project**
  - e. **Chronological description of the project as it was developed, complete with problems encountered.**
  - f. **A summary of the outcomes of the project. *(one page please)***  
*Pictures are not required but are preferred.*
2. **Displays must fit on the tables *no special accommodations will be provided***
3. **Displays must be self standing placed on a standard 3' x 6' table draped table *(skirted tables will be provided by the contest committee)***
4. **No commercial display boards please.**
5. **Displays may consist of; but, are not limited to the following: models, blueprints, posters, mechanical assemblies, wooden cabinets, automotive parts, electrical models. *(no electrical outlets will be provided)***

**PROCEDURES FOR SETUP**

Each contestant's badge will have a contestant "Number" on the back. Please attach the "Number" [portion only to the Display. A map of the contest area will be provided with the instructor's registration packet. Student should setup display on the first day of the State Conference, notebooks to be dropped off on the second day of competition. *(Displays must be removed by the announced time. Unclaimed displays will be disposed of by the Conference Center maintenance department)*
